

Terms & Conditions

PAYMENTS

Cash, Cheques, BACS or Google Checkout accepted. A deposit of £150 is payable on booking. Balance payable seven days before training begins. Companies will be invoiced for payment on 30 day terms.

CANCELLATIONS

Notice of cancellations must be given in writing (email acceptable). Cancellations made within 10 working days of the first day of training will be charged at £100 per training day, cancellations made within 5 working days of the first day of training will result in the full cost of training being charged.

DSA policy: Fees cannot be refunded if cancellation occurs within 3 working days of the test date.

RESPONSIBILITY

DS UK cannot be held responsible for cancelled or postponed training due to, Instructor illness, Mechanical breakdown or tests cancelled by the Driving Standards Agency (DSA Test centre)

It remains the responsibility of all test candidates to produce a current, valid driving licence. If a photocard type is held both photocard and paper parts of the licence are required. If an old style, paper only licence is held, another valid form of photo ID will be required e.g Passport

It is the clients responsibility when providing their own vehicle for training/test, to ensure that it is of a road legal condition and has the appropriate insurance and MOT certificate (if applicable).

It is the clients responsibility to ensure that they can meet the current requirements for reading a standard vehicle number plate at a distance of 20.5m as required by law.

It is the responsibility of the client to inform the trainer of any medication that they are currently taking or have taken in the last 48hrs that may impair their driving or judgement.

ROAD SAFETY

DS UK reserve the right to withdraw the use of a vehicle for Test, without notice.

We reserve the right to refuse training to any person who shows signs of being under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs.

We reserve the right to cancel training should a vehicle provided by the client be of an unacceptable standard.
